
Embrace the Middle East -

The massive explosion that ripped through **Beirut** on Tuesday 4 August destroyed three hospitals and severely damaged others, including the clinic run by one of our partners. At least 135 people have been reported dead, more than 5,000 injured and an estimated 300,000 people have had to evacuate their homes.


