

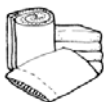
# PLEASE READ ME AND TAKE ME HOME

**SUNDAY 19 JANUARY 2020**

Isaiah's message is one of generous openness to all in the name of Israel's God, now seen as everyone's God. 'Saints' here means those who belong to God; the latter sense of being especially holy lies in the future. To be Christians is to stand on holy ground, where God is to be found.
