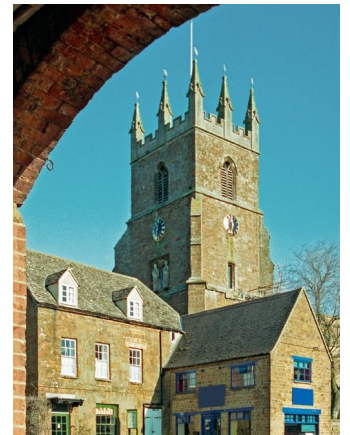

Unlike many rural parish churches, St Peter & St Paul is open seven days a week. Go through the door and you are struck by modern innovations. Up-to-date furnishings, audiovisual facilities and IT equipment mingle with the past. The odds are you will find a group of people having coffee in support of Katharine House Hospice, rehearsing for a concert, setting up tables for the Farmers' Market, Fair Trade or the latest exhibition. In the Living Room people plan a children's activity morning, staff and use an internet café, enjoy a Homework Club, broadcast readings, rehearse for the Boys' Brigade Band or have their toenails clipped! Deddington Primary School has the Church as its theatre as well as its place of worship.

Apart from Sunday and weekday worship and prayer, baptisms, weddings and funerals, a range of other activities takes place here. The recent list of concerts, exhibitions, readings, lectures, charity events and fund raisers is impressive. All users appreciate the space and facilities. This is a church that is beautiful and historic but no museum piece. It is also well-cared for, with an integral kitchen, Choir and Bell Ringers, and its visitors, specific and casual, generate income for other village establishments. One way or another, St Peter & St Paul enhances the life of the village.

However, as costs continue to rise, and with no regular financial support from the taxpayer for upkeep and maintenance, all aspects of the Church's work face curtailment.
