Remembrance will be observed at the war memorial only. There will be formal attendance of 6 people only, to represent our organisations and lay wreaths. There will be no parade, and anyone wishing to be present in the churchyard must observe social distancing to avoid the spread of Covid-19. The school children have decorated the crosses in the **Memorial Garden** this year in a particularly moving way. There are many symbols of hope as well as Remembrance which is particularly appropriate in this Covid shadowed year.



RBL Poppy Appeal: The Royal British Legion are not allowed to carry out a house to house collection this year and so have positioned boxes of poppies etc together with a collection tin in several places around the village including the church. As the church is open but not attended one of their collecting tins would be vulnerable and so donations to the Poppy Appeal should be put in the oak chest by the south door. One of the downsides of not having a church service on Remembrance Sunday is that we will not have a collection to contribute to the Poppy Appeal; for the last few years this collection has exceeded £500, so please give generously. Should you wish to donate to church funds please put the money in the small wall safe above the chest. If you want to leave a Stewardship Envelope, it will not fit in the wall safe so put it in the chest anyway. **Iain**
