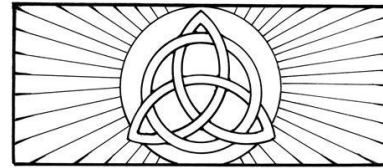


CHRISTIAN AID WEEK

Nicodemus visits Jesus to explore the relationship between Jesus and God the Father, and learns about the need to be born again, not just of water but of the Spirit, who brings new life and a fresh perspective. Nicodemus’ image of God expands – he learns that Jesus has come from God not to condemn the world, but to save it. God loves us, was alongside us in Jesus and lives in us now through the Holy Spirit – the Trinity in action.
