Solar panels generating electricity, some of which is fed into the national grid.

Fairtrade – tea, coffee etc are purchased from Traidcraft or other fair traders.

Toilets – supplies are eco-friendly, fair trade and our toilets are twinned.

Recycling – wax from used candles is melted and made into new candles

St Peter's boat for 1st Sunday service has now been recycled – the card to the kerbside collection, the broom handle back on the broom etc!
