So, while there is a real danger to wildlife in times of drought and dryness (**Ezekiel 15**), it can also be a chance for us to make sure life continues in abundance (**Psalms 65**). *Andy Lester, A Rocha UK's Head of Conservation*

### Top 5 actions for wildlife.

- 1) Water for birds and insects.
- 2) Food for wildlife.
- 3) Keep grass long to help retain moisture, give shelter for wildlife and keep topsoil from blowing away.
- 4) Keep your bushes unpruned. Shade will help reduce your garden's temperature, slowing the effect of drought.
- 5) Water fruit trees well, with a can not a hose. Don't waste water trying to keep the grass alive – instead, focus your attention on flowering and fruiting species. This will help to keep a food source for pollinating insects and for birds and other animals to feed.
