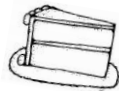


Harvest Supper 6.00pm - 8.30pm

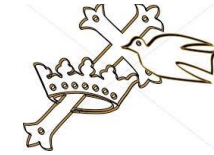

The story goes that when St Laurence, whose feast day we remembered on 10 August, was asked by the Roman governor to bring him the wealth of the Church, he gathered together the poor, the outcasts and the excluded and said that these little ones were the riches of the Church. For his faithfulness to today's Gospel reading, he was martyred.
